

University of Oregon English Minor Program

The English minor consists of 24 credits of approved course work (courses to be selected from those ENG, FLR*, HC* and/or WR prefix courses listed in the "Advising Supplement"). The "[Advising Supplement](#)" is available on the English department website and in the English department office, 118 PLC.

Restrictions:

- ❖ ONLY COURSES WITH THE PREFIX **ENG, FLR*, HC*** OR UPPER DIVISION **WR** MAY BE USED FOR THE MINOR.
- ❖ Excluded from the minor are :
 - (ENG 104, 105, 106) "Introduction to Literature"
 - ENG 401, 403, 405 and WR 121, 122, and 123.
- ❖ Of the total 24 credits, a maximum of 8 credits may be taken in lower-division courses.
- ❖ All upper-division course work for the minor must be taken in residency at the University of Oregon.
- ❖ All course work must be passed with the grade of mid-C or better. (Grades of C- or lower, and courses graded "P" will not count for the minor.)

* To count **FLR** or **HC** courses must have been listed on the annual [Advising supplement](#).
