

**The Deborah Tims Ellis Endowed Scholarship**

The Department of English invites applications from undergraduate English Majors for the Deborah Tims Ellis Endowed Scholarship, an award offered each year in recognition of outstanding academic achievement by an English Major to support their participation in study abroad programs.

In 2017, English majors can receive scholarship support of up to \$1500. Priority will be given to applications from English majors who plan to participate on the Galway summer study abroad program in the summer of 2017. Applications should be addressed to the Department Head, Department of English, University of Oregon, Eugene, OR, 97403.

Selection for scholarships will be based on academic merit, financial need, and a brief essay describing how the study-abroad program fits into undergraduate study plans and/or broader academic, cultural, or career interests.

If a student is awarded a scholarship and ultimately does not participate on the Galway summer program in 2017, the scholarship will be rescinded.

1. A completed application form. On Part I of the application, please be sure to note whether or not you want to be considered on the basis of financial need. Please note that those without demonstrable financial need are NOT excluded from applying for the scholarship but applicants' financial need may affect how scholarship funds are allocated.
2. For those claiming financial need, please attach an explanation or documentation of financial need.
3. A current unofficial transcript or degree audit.

Please note that eligibility for the scholarship is restricted to current UO English majors participating in the Galway program in the summer of 2017.
